**Support for Trauma and Addictions
Treatment System**

WHEREAS trauma and addictions treatment is urgently needed in Nunavut;

AND WHEREAS NTI has been an active participant of the multi-party feasibility process in 2017 and 2018 for a new Trauma and Addiction Treatment System in Nunavut, which includes three pillars: Regional On-the-Land Treatment and Healing Camps in all three regions beginning April 2019, a Trauma and Addictions Recovery Centre in Iqaluit with planned opening in 2023/24, and an Inuit Workforce as part of an overall treatment system for Trauma and Addictions (collectively the "Three Pillars");

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Board of Directors supports the Three Pillars for the Trauma and Addiction Treatment System as concluded through the feasibility study process;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT NTI will seek training funds from Makigiaqta Inuit Training Corporation for the development of Pillar 3 - Inuit Workforce for the Trauma and Addictions Treatment System.
