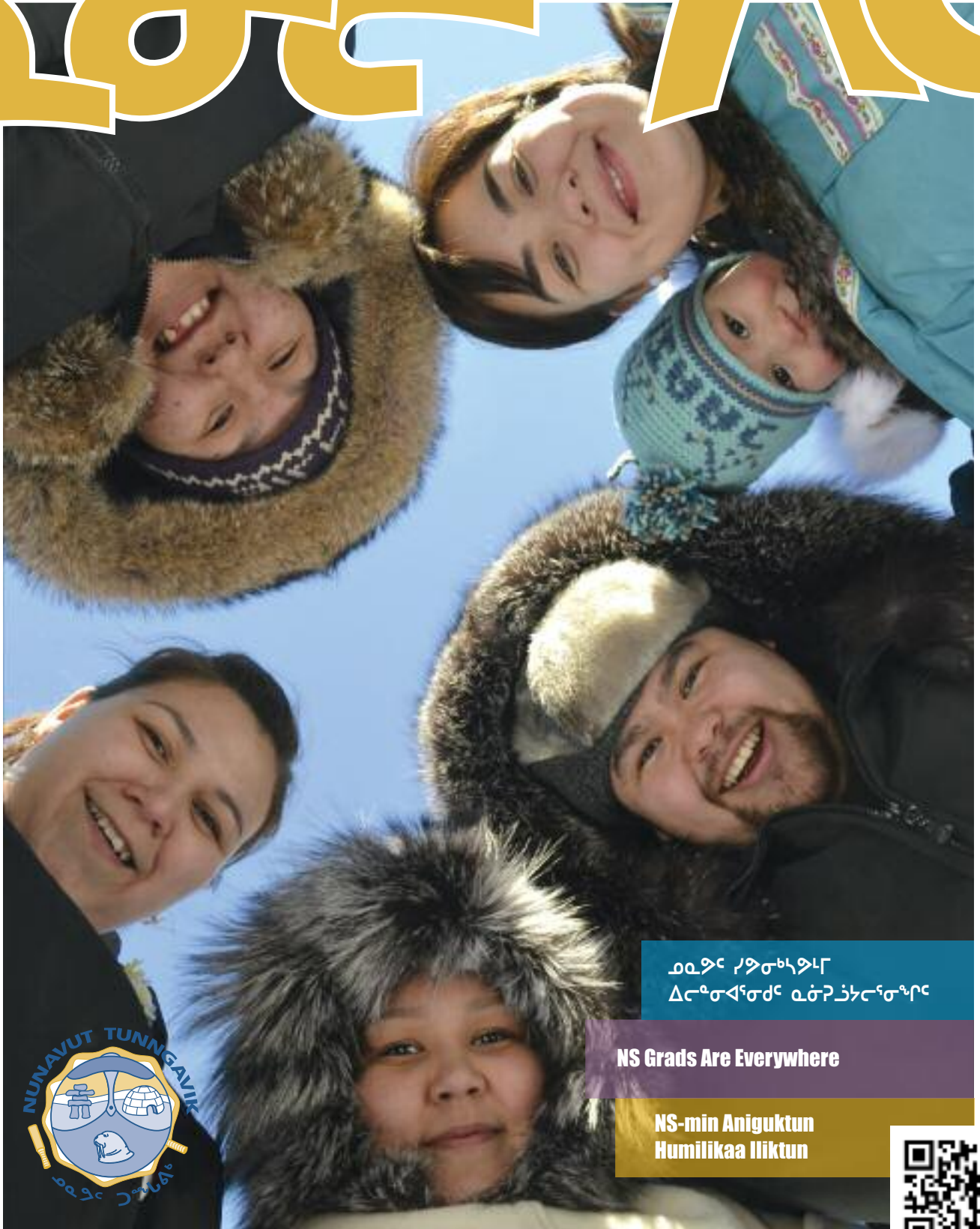

Q: In 2014/15 NS partnered with the Nunatsiavut Government, and brought in two students from Nunatsiavut. What direction is NS going with this?

A: (Morley) The current separation of Inuit across so many jurisdictions is an artificial one. Nunavut youth study their story here at NS, and although the names and details might change somewhat from region to region, it is still the same story of colonization and Inuit efforts to reverse that.

A: (Murray) The goal is to change the program's name from NS to Inuit Sivuniksavut (IS). We want to open the program up to youth from across Inuit Nunangat (Canada's Inuit regions), including from Alaska and Greenland. It would be amazing to see students from all Inuit regions studying together for a year!

Q: Share with us, your most memorable moment:

Q: In the classroom:

A: (Morley) Watching former students take on instructing at NS... working with them as colleagues.

A: (Murray) Not sure if I should admit it, but I fell asleep in my own class once! But hey... it was after lunch, the room was dark, we were watching a movie! But I want it known that I paid my \$20 fine in full at People's Court!

Q: During a year-end trip:

A: (Murray) I still have nightmares about the 10-hour bus ride over the Andes Mountains in Peru in 2007. But the encounters we had with the people living in the Amazon side of those mountains made it all worthwhile.

Q: Ukiumi 2014/15 NS ilaukatigihimayait Nunatsiavut Kavamatkut ovalo kaitkuihimayut malgunik ilihak-tukhanik Nunatsiavumit. Namungaulika NSkut hamanga?

A: (Morley) Ublumi aviktugutait Inuit tamaat nunaini titi-gakafukhimayut. Nunavumi inuulgamiit ilihakhimayut inminik ukautainik hamani NSkuni ovalo atiit ovalo ukautait aalangu-laaktut ilaani aviktukhimayunit, aatjikutauniaktut ukautait kanuk Kavamatkut katitikhimayait ovalo Inuit akhuukhimayait utiktilugit tahapkoa.

A: (Murray) Tikitumayait aalanguklugit pilihimayuit atiit NSkunit Inuit Sivuniksvumut (IS). Angmagumayavut pilihimayuit inuulgaminut tamaat ilanganut Inuit Nunangat (Kanatami Inuit Nunait), ilautinahualugit Inuit Alaskamit ovalo Akukitukmit. Aliananiaktuk takuyaanganik ilihaktut ilihakatigiiklutik taimaatut ukiumi.

Q: Ukakatigilaakiuk uvaptinut aliagikpiaktanik:

Q: Ilihakiini?:

A: (Morley) Kungiakhugit ilihakhimayut ilihaktilikhutik NSkuni... kungiakhugit ilihaktikatiigihugit.

A: (Murray) Nauna ukaalagiami, kihimi hinaakhimayunga ilihaktititilunga! Kihimi ilaa, nigitaakhimagapta, nani ikluak taaktitlugu kungiaktitlugit! Kihimi nalungitukha akilikhimay-atka \$20mik tamaat Inuit Naalakviani!!

focus is on academic learning, but that can't happen properly if there are other things in life holding a person back. Many students find themselves in circumstances where they don't feel up to the challenge and they fall on their face and see themselves as failures. This is a typical experience for students going anywhere for post-secondary. NS is a place where there are people who will help them get back up and try again, where they won't be judged.

Q: What are your dreams? What do you envision for NS 30 years from now?

A: (Morley) We never could have predicted the experience we would have and where the program is today, so who knows where it might go. I remember one day laughing with a board member, dreaming about our own building and how unrealistic that was, yet here we are. While the program has developed on its own in isolation, it's time for that to change. I think there's room for closer ties with universities and other colleges. We have a great relationship developing with Carleton University.

Q: Ukiumi Iniktigutainik Autlaagutainut?:

A: (Murray) Kukukatakhimayunga autlaakhimagapta kulinik ikaanik akhaluutikut kaangani Andes Kaiktuini, Perumi 2007mi. Kihimi takuyaanganik aalanik Inunik inuuyut talvani Amazon Napaaktukyuangani kihimi alianaktuk.

Q: Ilihaktut ilihagutainik?:

A: (Morley) Ukiumi 1999, Ilihaktivut hivulimik kungiakti-himanmata Ottawa ilitagititlugit April 1mik. Talvanga, kungiakti-faakhimayut ilihaktut iniktigutainik. Kungiakhimayut amigaitut angayukaat aliahukpiakhimayut. Puigukhimaitunga kanuk John Amagoalik kaklitikhuni ikhivautaminik ovalo kungiakhuni ilihaktunut kungiagutainik. Ilaa, kulvihimayuk, ilaa, aliagikpi-agamiuk. Pilihaalikhimayut nutaamik pilihimayuit. Inuuviviniit kungiaktigutait akhut ilauliktuk ilanganut pilihimayuit ublumi ovalo ilihaktut ilihakhimayainik talvanit utikihimayait angil-gaminut.
