Visit or Return of the Deceased

WHEREAS, the Government of Canada was formerly responsible for transporting Inuit to southern hospitals for medical treatment; and

WHEREAS, those people who died during medical treatment were buried in cemeteries in southern Canadian cities; and

WHEREAS, due to the high cost of travel, many Inuit families are unable to visit and see the graves of their deceased relatives;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Members direct NTI to communicate with the Government of Canada with the aim of obtaining Government of Canada funding in order to transfer to cemeteries in Nunavut, the bodies of those Inuit who died during the era in which the Government of Canada was responsible for medical travel.
