

Nunavut Tunngavik Foundation Scholarship Application

Application Overview

Nunavut Tunngavik Inc. administers the Scholarships Program, held in trust under the Nunavut Tunngavik Foundation (NTF) that was created to receive the remainder surplus from of the Common Experience Payment Trust Fund in accordance with the Residential School Settlement Agreement.

NTF offers two (2) Scholarships:

Post-Secondary Scholarship (\$2,500) – for students enrolled in a recognized post-secondary institution such as a college or university for;

- An education program that leads to a bachelor degree or higher degree,
- A diploma-leading program that is two academic years or longer in duration,
- A post-secondary preparatory program with a duration of at least one academic year or longer, the objective of which is to prepare a student to enroll into a degree-leading program or a diploma-leading program as described above.

The Post-Secondary Scholarship will be awarded in two \$1,250 installments (September and January). Students must be enrolled in full-time studies for both the fall and winter semesters. Students must provide NTF with a Confirmation of Enrollment letter prior to the second installment pay-out. Transcripts or class schedules will **NOT** be accepted as proof of enrollment.

Skills & Employment Advancement Scholarship

(\$1,500) – for students in a program that is four weeks or longer, but less than two years, related to;

- Trades training,
- Skill development training,
- Upgrading in a program (A.B.E., P.A.S.S., G.E.D., Foundation Year, pre-trades, etc)

Post-Secondary Scholarship application intake period is from July 19 – August 31, 2021. Post-Secondary Scholarships are available to each recipient once per year.

Skills & Employment Advancement Scholarship intake will be open to applicants throughout the year to enable students to access funding outside of the traditional academic year. Once budgetary restrictions have been met, applications will no longer be accepted.

How do I apply?

First, review this document and the application form. Once you complete your application, use the checklist to make sure you have included all required materials.

You are eligible to apply if you are:

- Enrolled under the Nunavut Agreement
- Enrolled as a full-time student in a recognized program
- Meet the individual scholarship criteria

Students must be enrolled in full-time studies in both September and January semesters to be eligible for the Post-Secondary Scholarship.

Students who do not complete the academic year may be required to pay back a partial amount they received from NTI.

Funds will not be dispersed to students until proof of enrollment is submitted once the September and January semesters begin.
